



## Invitation to Submit a Proposal for NABP's Educational Poster Session!

The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy® (NABP®) seeks proposals for its annual Educational Poster Session, which will take place on Friday morning during the 122<sup>nd</sup> NABP Annual Meeting. There is also an opportunity for presenters to showcase their work during a live Poster Session webinar on June 11, 2026.

### Summary Guidelines for Submitting a Poster Proposal:

- Poster topics must adhere to the overall Poster Session theme of "Illuminating Public Health Protection."
- Include a title for the poster, provide a brief summary or abstract of the poster topic, and explain how the poster relates to the theme.
  - Posters may be descriptive, scientific, or informational in nature.
  - Possible topics include policy development, legislative issues, public health initiatives, technology, and research results that explore advancing public health, among others.
  - Encore presentations are accepted for consideration as long as they fit the theme.
  - Posters will not be judged.
- List the name(s), degrees/designations, and title(s) of the individual(s) who will present the poster at the Annual Meeting or during the webinar. Presenters must be in person and on site for the session on Friday, May 15, 2026, from 7:30 to 10:15 AM EDT in Boston, MA, or online for the entire two-hour webinar on June 11, 2026.
  - Only an individual who will be available to present on site at the Annual Meeting or during the webinar may submit a proposal. Proposals may not be submitted on behalf of someone else.
  - No more than two individuals may present a poster. Student posters may have up to two student presenters and must have one credentialed advisor.
- Indicate whether the proposal should be considered for presentation at the in-person meeting, live webinar, or both.
- Presenters must be readily available via email in the months leading up to their presentation to communicate with NABP staff about the poster and be prepared to submit additional information.

### Special Notes:

- Presenters may be eligible to receive Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE)-accredited continuing pharmacy education (CPE) credit.
  - If you plan to earn CPE during the Poster Session in Boston, please plan accordingly and have a qualified representative staffing the poster board display in your absence.
- Pharmacy school students who are selected to display a poster and also present it in Boston or virtually will receive a complimentary voucher valued at \$75 to take the Pre-NAPLEX®, a practice examination for students preparing for the North American Pharmacist Licensure Examination® (NAPLEX®).
